## SCHOLARSHIPS

### ELIGIBILITY:

- You must be a member of the Alabama Dance Council to apply.
- Recipients are responsible for all other expenses including registration fee (\$10), travel, lodging, meals, etc.
- Recipients are expected to attend the entire festival weekend. Please do not apply if you cannot attend all three days.
- Dancers must be grade 6 or older.
- College, grad students, and adult dancers may also apply.
- Applicants must demonstrate financial need.
- Applicants may be awarded a full or partial scholarship.

# VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

You must be a current member of the ADC to apply. There are four opportunities to volunteer at the festival:

- ➔ **Volunteer:** Works a minimum of 4 hours during the festival (Usher, BOH, etc.). Receives discounted Observer Volunteer registration. No classes. Must be 18+.
- ➔ **Chief Ambassador:** Works the entire festival weekend, assisting with registration, check-in, and other duties, in exchange for free festival Observer admission for themselves and one (Purple/Orange/Green) admission dancer. Ambassador must be 25+.
- ➔ **Dancer Ambassador:** Works and takes class the entire festival weekend, assisting with attendance, check-in, and other duties, in exchange for free festival admission for themselves. Must be 18+.
- ➔ **Driver:** Works the entire weekend driving faculty or running local errands in exchange for free festival admission. Must be 21+, with a vehicle, valid auto insurance and driver license.
